## MEMORIAL AND SPONSORS AWARDS

The West Prince Music Festival is committed to reward each participant for his or her own individual performance. Each performance is adjudicated according to its own merit and not in comparison to others. Each participant will receive positive instruction and encouragement.

1. All awards depend upon the generosity of the West Prince businesses, private donors and the general public, and in certain circumstances **may be subject to change**. Not all awards may be given in every festival year.
2. While marks are not made public and are represented by the gold, silver and bronze seals, adjudicators will consider contestants (with the exception of bands) who have obtained a mark of 85% in at least two classes of their discipline and/or category for the following awards.

*Eugene General Store Award* ..... for highest mark in junior piano  
*Cox and Palmer Award* ..... for highest mark in intermediate piano  
*Evangeline-Central Credit Union Award* ..... for highest mark in senior piano  
*O'Leary Guardian Drugs and PEI Roadbuilders and Heavy Construction's Brian Campbell Memorial Award* ..... for highest overall average of the music festival (contestants must compete in two or more disciplines in order to qualify for this award)  
*PEI Registered Music Teachers' Association Award* .....for outstanding performance by a pupil in the PEI school system.  
*Tignish Credit Union Award* ..... for highest average in vocal solo  
*West Prince Arts Council Award* ..... for highest average in piano  
*Long and McQuade Award* ..... for highest average in 3 solo classes (senior)  
*West Prince Music Festival Award* (in various categories)
