EAST PRINCE MUSIC FESTIVAL SCHOLARSHIPS, TROPHIES AND AWARDS

To be eligible for a festival award, solo contestants must compete in a minimum of two solo performance classes in the same discipline, using standard repertoire. Piano Contemporary Idioms, RCM popular music classes, Method Book Classes and Graded Studies are eligible for awards and Provincial Festival. Junior Music Theatre and Composition awards require one class only, Composition is not eligible for Provincial Festival. Quick Study and Sight-reading Classes are not eligible for awards or Provincial Festival. Special Festival Awards may be given upon the recommendation of the adjudicators.

All awards depend upon the generosity of businesses, private donors, service clubs and the general public, and in certain circumstances may be subject to change. Not all awards may be given in every festival year. While marks are not made public and are represented by the gold, silver and bronze seals, adjudicators will consider participants (with the exception of bands) who have obtained a mark of 85% in at least two classes of their discipline and/or category.

The East Prince Music Festival is committed to reward each participant for his or her own individual performance. Each performance is adjudicated according to its own merit and not in comparison to others. Each participant will receive positive instruction and encouragement.

Age categories for awards are as follows:

Junior	11 years and under
Intermediate.	14 years and under
Senior	17 years and under
Advanced	28 years and under

All awards are Adjudicator chosen and are subject to change, depending on the standard of performance, on the number of entries and on donations received.

- The time of each competition and the order of competing will be shown in the official Program which will be available approximately two weeks before the opening of the Festival.
