MANUAL ENTRY FORMS

- Schools with many entries may use a typed list rather than individual entry forms
- The forms must be completed in their entirety and accompanied by payment in full to Queens County Music Festival Association. **DUETS ARE \$12.00 AND THE FEE MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY. THEY WILL BE REJECTED OTHERWISE.**
- Entry forms are available at www.peikiwanismusicfestival.ca and can be processed on line.
- E-Mail addresses are necessary so we can send you an email regarding changes etc.

We prefer that you enter your students on line and use the PayPal payment system. It is easy and helps us a lot. There is a \$0.30 cent transaction fee for each on-line entry, however you can enter 20 entries at one time and still only pay \$0.30 for your transaction. Help the festival save money and enter your students in one transaction.

QUEENS COUNTY MUSIC FESTIVAL AWARDS

To be eligible for a festival award, solo contestants must compete in a minimum of two solo performance classes in the same discipline, using standard repertoire. Piano Classes 404-435 (Contemporary Idioms), RCM popular music classes 436-442, Method Book Classes (443-458) and Graded Studies are eligible for awards and Provincial Festival. Junior Music Theatre and Composition awards require one class only, Composition is not eligible for Provincial Festival. Quick Study and Sight Reading Classes are not eligible for awards or Provincial Festival.

Intermediate, Senior and Advanced Music Theatre QCMFA awards require **two** solo classes. You may choose from Up-tempo, Ballad and/or Gilbert and Sullivan classes. Provincial Festival requires one class only.

Awards designated by discipline and age categories are granted on the basis of marks, and will be awarded to the contestant(s) with the highest average(s), based on their top two marks in the discipline. Other, un-designated awards are granted on the basis of recommendations from the adjudicators.

"Presented to an outstanding Intermediate, Senior or Advanced performer in each of the following categories: Piano, Voice, Strings and Instrumental, in recognition of excellence. The adjudicator will make this choice based on marks and overall musicianship."

P.E.I. Registered Music Teachers' Association "Kay Linkletter Award" \$100.00

This award is donated by The Prince Edward Island Registered Music Teachers' Association. "Presented to outstanding Intermediate, Senior or Advanced students in recognition of high standards." Two awards of \$50.00 each - one for **strings** and one for **instrumentalists**.

Louise Pritchard Award \$100.00

This award is donated by the friends of Louise Pritchard, presented to an Intermediate Piano, Senior Piano, or Advanced piano contestant who has earned excellent marks and who demonstrated highly expressive playing and good all-round musicianship. *This award shall be presented no more than twice to any one competitor.*

Al Martin Award \$500.00

This award is donated by Margaret Dumont and Elizabeth Bushell in memory of Al Martin. Presented to a Senior or Advanced Piano contestant who demonstrates exceptional performance abilities **in at least three solo classes** at the Senior/Advanced levels. *This can be divided between two disciplines or participants and may be won no more than two times by one competitor.*

The Audrey Gillis Award\$250.00

This award is sponsored by The Rotary Club Charlottetown in honor of Audrey Gillis. This award will be presented to a festival participant, aged 18 and under, who demonstrates exceptional performance abilities in a Recital Class (minimum requirement RCM Grade 8), two short movements from a concerto or sonata, **or** one long movement from a concerto or sonata and one other solo performance class in the same discipline. Contestants must obtain a Gold Standard in the designated classes . Available for consideration in all disciplines.

Regis and Joan Duffy Award\$500.00

This award is sponsored by The Duffy Foundation. This award will be presented to a festival participant, aged 18 and over, who demonstrates exceptional performance abilities in a Recital Class (minimum requirement RCM Grade 8), two short movements from a concerto or sonata, or one long movement from a concerto or sonata and one other solo performance class in the same discipline. Contestants must obtain a Gold Standard in the designated classes . Available for consideration in all disciplines.

Donated by Heather Campbell for the best performance of a Canadian work in piano at the Junior or Intermediate level.

The Canadian Music Award - Class 545 or 546 \$50.00

Donated by Heather Campbell for the best performance of a Canadian work in piano at the Senior or Advanced levels.

The Canadian Music Award - Class 265, 266 or 267 \$50.00

Donated by Lori Linkletter for the best performance of a Canadian work from vocal repertoire at the Junior or Intermediate levels.

To be presented to a Senior or Advanced performer of piano in recognition of exceptional performance abilities in at least two solo classes at the Senior/Advanced levels. **This award is intended for a music student who plans to pursue piano studies at University.**

The Brian Campbell Memorial Award (Adjudicator's Choice Award) \$50.00
Donated by The P.E.I. Road Builders and Heavy Equipment Association. To be presented to a deserving school ensemble in the Instrumental category. **Ensemble must have entered competitively.**

The Luther Ellis Memorial Award for Traditional String Music \$50.00
Donated by Kay Linkletter in memory of her father. To be presented to an individual who best captures the spirit of traditional fiddle music. All traditional string solo classes eligible (Page 53 in syllabus)

The Elise Hiscott Memorial Award for Intermediate Piano \$50.00
Donated by Leslie Hiscott and family in memory of Elise, a piano teacher in Charlottetown for many years.
