Flautist and pianist Morgan Saulnier has been a sessional instructor in the UPEI Music Department since 2009. Her performances bring passion, immense expression, and an ability to evoke emotional engagement from her audiences. Her pedagogy focuses on getting the music off of the page, by encouraging and guiding her students in both the technical proficiency, and the musical interpretation of the repertoire.

Morgan Saulnier holds a Masters in Flute Performance from Memorial University and a Bachelor of Music from the University of Prince Edward Island. She has performed in several master classes and competitions across the country, receiving instruction from Michel Debost, Susan Hoepfner, Camille Churchfield, and others.

Ms. Saulnier is Principal Flute of the PEI Symphony Orchestra, a core member of eklektikok - a chamber ensemble focused on new Canadian works. She maintains an active role in the classical and musical theatre scene on Prince Edward Island - in high demand as a flute and piano educator, rehearsal and audition pianist, soloist, and collaborator - working with the Charlottetown Festival, Confederation Centre of the Arts, various soloists, choirs, dancers, and theatre productions. In 2014, she released a CD of French Flute Music with pianist Mark Ramsay.
